Digital Drawing for Animation

Q. How big are your classes?

A. Classes are capped at eight students, this is to ensure each student receives individual care and attention.

Q. Can I show up to class without enrolling?

A. Unfortunately walk-ins will not be accepted as students.

This is for safety, crowd control and to streamline the learning process for all students.

Q. Can homeschool children attend the class?

A. Absolutely! In fact, the 2-4pm class is specifically designed to accommodate homeschool students so they can explore digital art in a safe learning environment.

Q. How much are lessons?

A. Lessons are \$40 per class if you would like to have a casual enrollment.

The recommended option however is the eight week term for \$240. Not only are you committing to a more cohesive course structure, you are also saving \$80!

Q. Why are there two different prices?

A. I understand how useful it is to have a drop in option for busy families, however with the structure of the course I highly recommend paying for the full eight weeks.

Not only will you receive a more complete learning experience by committing to every week, but you will also receive a discount of \$80 (or two free weeks of lessons!) if you pay the full fee.

Q. How do I pay?

A. Cash is preferred, however I do accept bank transfers and pay IDs (as long as the money is transferred prior to class).

Q. What do I need to bring?

A. Please refer to the supply list found [here](#).

In short, you will need to bring

- A drawing tablet (ipad or similar) **with drawing software installed**
- A drawing stylus (apple pen or similar)
- A charging cable for your tablet
- Notebook, pencil, eraser, pen

Q. I don't have a digital drawing tablet, can I still attend class?

A. Sorry no :(

As this class has been designed specifically for artwork of a digital nature, students without a drawing tablet will not be able to participate in class.

However! That doesn't mean you shouldn't keep drawing! Keep it up !

Q. What the heck is a drawing stylus?

A. A drawing stylus is a tool used for digital illustration, such as an apple pen. Brand names aren't required for class.

Q. Am I too young/old?

A. At this point in time I am accepting students from ages 10-17.

Q. Do I need to have experience as an artist?

A. Prior experience with other art classes is appreciated but not required! At a minimum, students must have an interest in drawing and wish to further their craft.

Q. Well! I've enrolled. Now what?

A. Great! Welcome to the club!

I will be in contact with you shortly in regards to dates, payment options, meeting points, and to organise a meeting (if needed) to introduce myself and get to know the student.

Q. Wait... Where am I going?

A. Please refer to the enrollment confirmation and student placement email for confirmation on locations and times. If you've lost the email - just give me a message!

Q. Do you accept Creative Kids Vouchers?

A. At this point in time I cannot accept creative kids vouchers as payment.

Q. Do you accept Afterpay?

A. At this time I do not accept afterpay as payment.

Q. I am not able to attend all my classes - will I be charged?

A. I highly recommend trying to attend class each week, but it is understandable if you are unable to make every class!

Classes are **non-refundable**.

This does mean if you have paid upfront, I cannot provide any refunds for classes missed.

Please be aware that if you are unable to commit to classes regularly, your slot may be filled by another student.

Q. I want to try out for a few weeks, then switch to paying upfront. Can I do that?

A. If you have chosen to pay week by week, I am not able to switch you to the eight week payment deal halfway through the term due to the sizable discount provided.

For this reason (as well as the course structure) I recommend any potential students to seriously consider the eight week price (2 free lessons! Yippee!).

Q. Why wasn't I accepted?

- a. Firstly, it's not a reflection of you or your art! Class sizes are very small, and as such I will not be able to accept everyone who applies. You will be kept on a waiting list if a space does open up.
